"My knowledge and database of vendors florists, entertainers, locations, caterers and more — can save a couple not only so much time and energy, but also in the pricing they can secure. The relationships I have with the vendors I recommend are work with me to help meet a budget."

"There are not enough good things that I can say about Ruth and her dedication to her couples," said caterer Ricki Epstein of Affairs to Cater, who has worked with her on many events. "Every nice word there is can be used to describe this beautiful person who cares so much about her clients. It really is as though their important day is her own and she'll leave nothing to chance.

preparation, direction of rehearsal, wedding and reception and more.

"The top stresses when planning a wedding are budget, coordinating the wants of the couple and their parents as to what 'the dream' of the wedding means, and the conflicts of daily life, whether it's going to school or involvement in work, that makes planning and attending to all of the details so difficult," said Spirer. "I can take any budget and help the client create their dream. Sometimes it may take a disc jockey for \$1500 instead of a 10-piece band

at many thousands of dollars, but with the right entertainer, the same results, people dancing and celebrating late into the night, can be reached. A planner takes all of those pressures away, finds the answers, and brings back the package without excess decision-making."

"I can't imagine planning our wedding without her help," said Tali Briskman Macfud, who married her beshert, Shahar, on June 25 at the Westin Park Central. "She took quite a load off us and instead of visiting numerous hotels, she narrowed the list to four that would meet our budget and either allow us to bring in a kosher caterer or who had their own kosher kitchen. I can't imagine not having had her help."

When Macfud's mother Barbara passed away last year, her father Mark Briskman took the role of father-of-the-bride beyond the traditional walk down the aisle. "I wanted Tali to have a beautiful wedding and, while I know that Barbara would have known what to do, I didn't.
